MOONOLITH – Monument to the Moon and the stars was a site-specific public space installation in Ljubljana’s Republic Square, a monumental public space foremost characterized by its emptiness. This vast empty square in the city centre is bordered by the Slovenian Parliament, two skyscrapers that represent symbolic gate to the parliament, a shopping centre and one of the biggest public sculptures in the country, a monument of revolution. MOONOLITH was joined on site by MOONOLITH LAB (MOTO – mobile unit of the Museum of Architecture and Design) where workshops and lectures took place. The sound and light interactive monument was open to public from 3 December 2015 to 4 January 2016, offering a space of contemplation for passers-by during the daytime and allowing visitors to interact with it daily from 5 pm to 9 pm.
