



THE INCLUSION OF THE FUTURE USERS IN THE PROCESS OF CREATING THE SPACE WAS THE KEY ELEMENT FOR THE SUSTAINABILITY OF THE PROJECT. THE CHILDREN, TEENAGERS AND OTHER NEIGHBORS LEARNED NOT ONLY HOW TO CREATE A PLACE THAT THEY WANT TO USE IN A NEW AND CREATIVE WAY, BUT ALSO TO FEEL LIKE IT BELONGS TO THEM, TO RESPECT IT AND HELP IT REMAIN SUSTAINABLE IN FUTURE BY PROTECTING IT. THE CHILDREN SOON STARTED DISCOVERING NEW WAYS OF USING THE SPACE, AND STARTED CREATING THEIR OWN GAMES BASED ON THE PAINTED PATTERNS ON THE FLOOR. AFTER THE WORK PROCESS ENDED, THE TEAM MEMBERS CREATED WORKSHOPS WITH CHILDREN AND TEENAGERS AT LEAST ONCE PER WEEK.
