Usage of the space around the fountain and also applied materials for the new interventions contributed in forming a completely new public space within Belgrade fortress as a whole. This approach emphasized the importance of the interaction between old and new for the purpose of presentation of the heritage and making it available to all visitors. The new ramp as a functional element, with the supporting walls covered with Corten steel wooden handrails and path covered with decking, demonstrates how new elements can be incorporated into historical monuments without damaging the history of the monument and also opening up the viewing of all elements to all including the unveiled fortification parts.



This public space with the historical monuments is now visited and admired by local, as well as Turkish, and International tourists. Centuries ago Belgrade fortress was a place where major battles occurred, and today this fortress is an open place for every visitor, a kind of open school of history.
