I'M UAU_INSIDE OUT

The main projects developed by I'M UAU with regard to “Ion Mincu” University of Architecture and Urbanism’s public spaces are structured in two major programs :

- 1. FLADER_ING - design and construction of urban furniture using wood and ceramic blocks ; the PRINTRE LINII (BETWEEN LINES) and b_LOC workshops are included in this program.
- 2. P_TER - which plans on inviting different artists to paint murals on the blind walls surrounding the interior courtyard terrace.

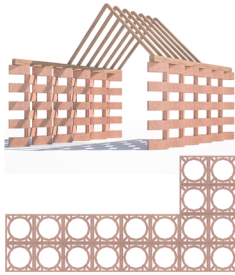
The aim of this project is to revitalise the entire interior courtyard of “Ion Mincu” University of Architecture and Urbanism, step by step.

The first phase of the b_LOC project consisted of building two 6-meter-long benches and was completed by students of the University.
