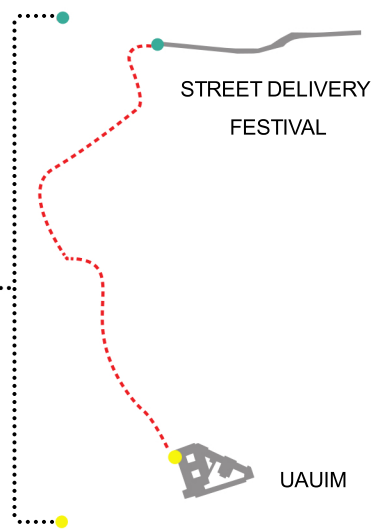
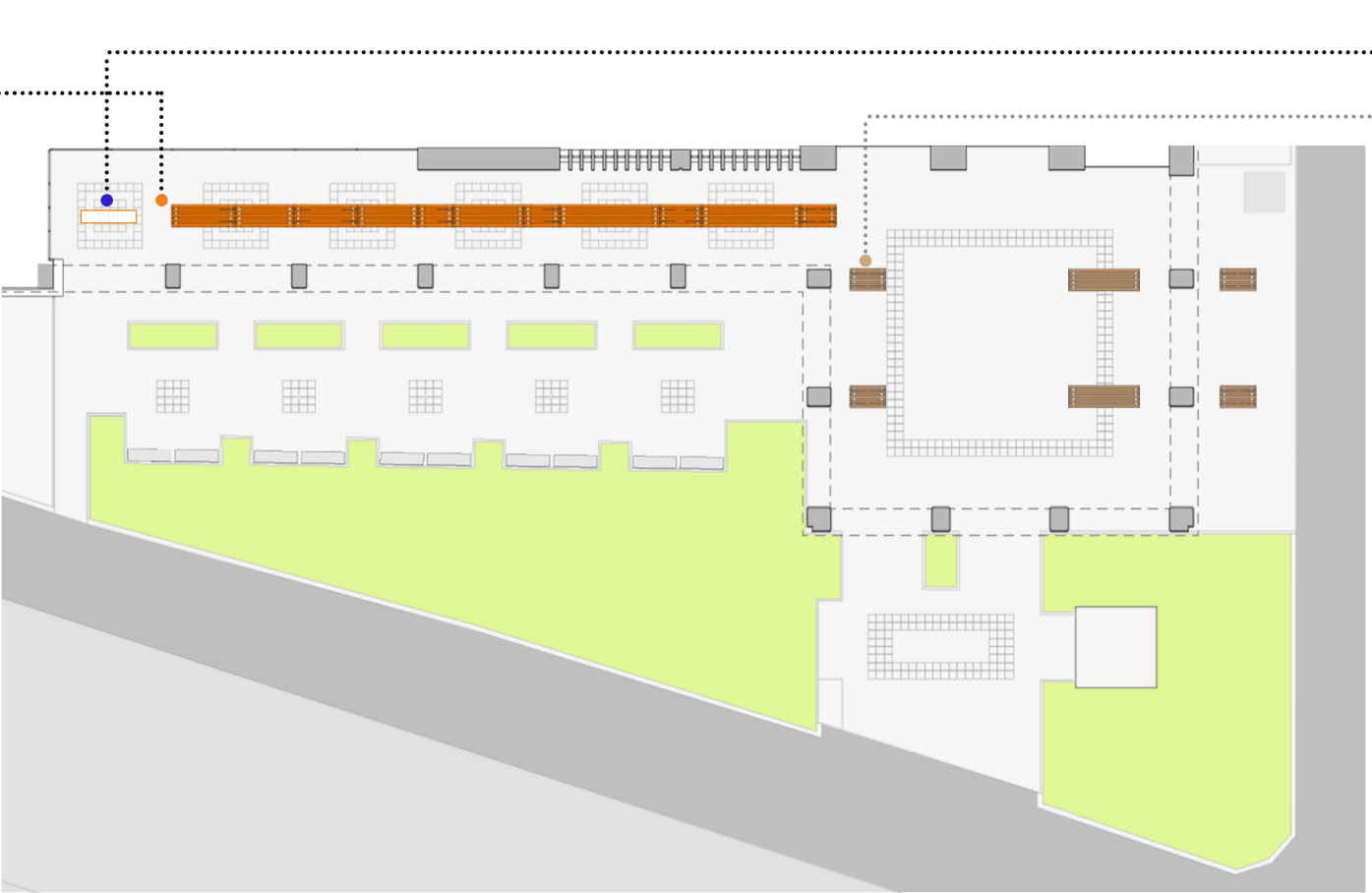
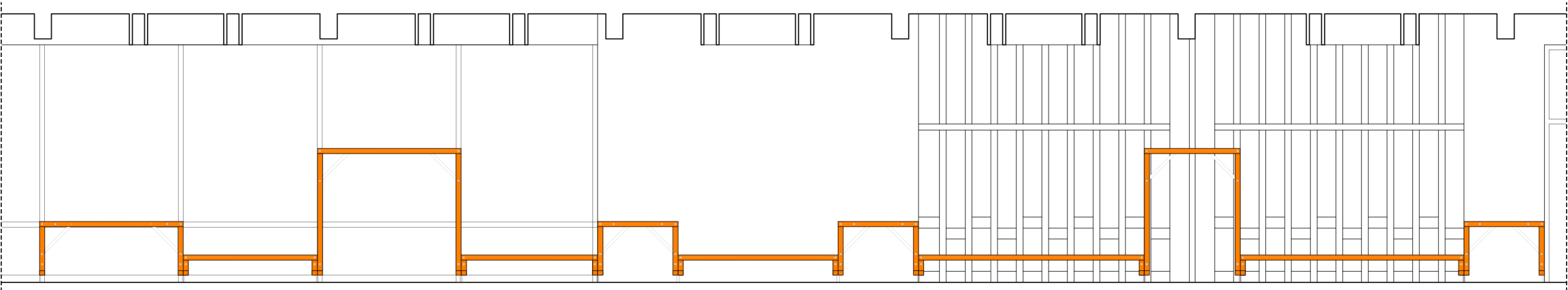


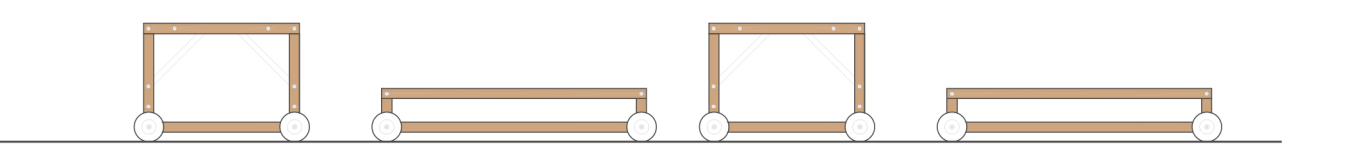
CODE FOR WORK: K223 UAUIM has an extremely privileged position within the city : a central one.

The goal : to strenghten the link between the main entrance in the University and the city.

Method: a 25-meter-long bench underneath the portico.



- **TRANSFORM_SD** - UP-CYCLE workshop for children held at Street Delivery festival by architecture students
- **CERAMFORM 3.0** - Ceramics workshop for students, held at UAUIM: ceramic tiles modelling + lamp making
- **TR_AFF** - was the 'booth' of the street festival, built from scraps resulted after building of PRINTRE_LINII
- **PRINTRE LINII II BETWEEN LINES II** - A study of fluidity and flexibility within the public space. The next step is to create a mobile one - using the same modules as PRINTRE LINII I, but on wheels this time.
