The tax-free area shut down in the end of the 80ies. The set up of the School of Design HGK on the area has been the most important impact of the site transformation. Morger Dettli architects and Müller Sigrist architects with Westpol landscape architects won the architectural competition. From 2006 the area has been opened up graduately to the public. The open space of this site takes an important task in a long-term transformation process. Evident was to find the right strategy that is able to react to the changing needs without being determinated.
