
The Construction Jam

Set up as an open construction site, the kiosk invited the neighbours to transform it by sharing their personal skills and stories throughout different jamming sessions. These exchanges generated a space for conversation and for the transmission of skills from the elderly to the young.

Walks around the block redeveloped a local awareness of fruit trees present in the neighbourhood and provided fruits for improvised jam making sessions. A neighbour's old pillow stitched up with fruit graphics became the kiosk's flag and a continuous flow of hands, hammers, screwdrivers and paint collectively fixed up the main structure.
