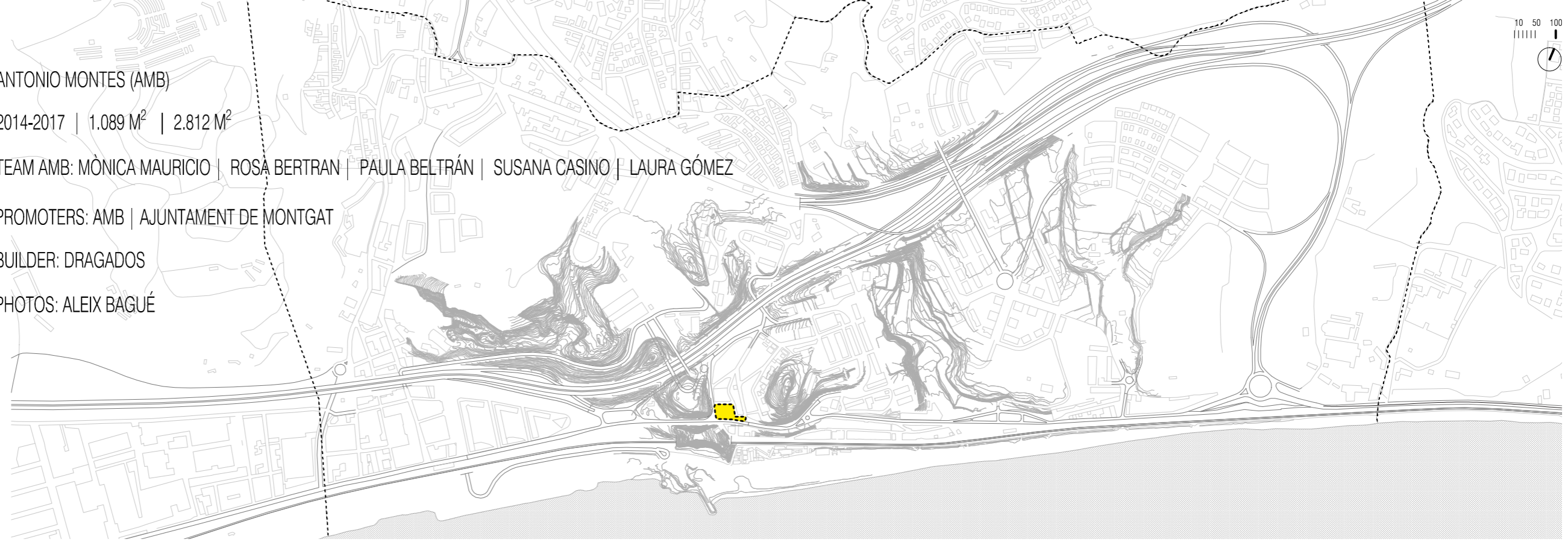

The remodelling of Plaça de la Vila aims to accumulate and concentrate the free area for pedestrians around the Town Hall by placing the public space at the same level as the Town Hall.

This change in level creates a raised platform above the N-II that reveals the sea once again, while becoming the roof for a new underground car park.

The rationalisation of the elements related to vehicle mobility is complemented by the relocation of the bus stops and the entrances to the car park from the side streets, releasing the façade with the seafront.

Granite slabs with variable and changing fragments, like the sea, are used for the paving. The gentle slopes that make up the platform and the location of the steps on its perimeter enhance the views of the sea. Following this criterion, the furniture is a linear bench.

The boundaries of the square, which are currently vague, are defined by trees lining the shoreline: a palm grove in a grid that simultaneously provides shade for the square.

The remodelling of the stairs leading to the side street follows criteria of clarity, layout and versatility that enable pedestrians to use this street which provides access to the coast.
