2 Cathedral Square

Cathedral Square forms the centre-piece of the Viking Triangle. The intention was to restore the prominence of the Cathedral and the Deanery. A line of granite benches were placed along the northern edge and some existing trees were removed to make an open space. A limestone plinth makes a new accessible entrance to the Deanery, doubling up as a stage during outdoor events.
