

PREVIOUS STATE

Renewing Plaça Catalunya is a response of the will of the municipality of El Prat de Llobregat to establish the new center of the city in its growth to the south. This has been a long urban process that began back in 2006 with the demolition of the old municipal slaughterhouse, the subsequent construction of Centric Cultural Centre; and the building of a new metro station on line 9 that links the city with Barcelona. Despite its central position, the site itself was an open and poorly qualified urban space, fact that has been the argument for its renewal. A new car-park has been built underneath the square as well.
